

# Presenters' Information

## Oral Presentation

1. All rooms will be equipped with an LCD projector, a KVM extension system, and an official PC. Each oral presenter is asked to connect her/his own note PC to the LCD projector (an analog RGB cable; D-sub 15 pins) and the KVM extension system (along a USB cable) or to upload the files to the official PC using a USB memory prior to the session or during break. Please make sure that your PC and USB memory are not infected with computer viruses. The official PC contains Microsoft Windows XP and PowerPoint 2010. Room staff will be ready to help you with the preparation.

2. The conference will have a Speaker Ready Room at Room H from May 23 (Mon) to 26 (Thu). Oral presenters can visit the Speaker Ready Room before the presentation in order to ensure that her/his PC and/or electronic files are compatible with the LCD projector and PC provided by ICAS 2011. This procedure is highly recommended for presenters who are going to use the official PC.

3. Presentations may be plenary lectures (60 min.), keynote lectures, invited lectures, and contributing lectures. Presentation times vary of keynote, invited and contributing lectures depending on the types of presentations and sessions. Please confirm your presentation time on program.

## Poster Presentation

Poster sessions will be held from May 23 (Mon) to 25 (Wed) at the Annex Hall of Kyoto International Conference Center. On each day different posters will be presented. The poster sessions will take place from 12:30 to 14:30. From 12:30 to 13:30 posters with odd numbers should be presented and from 13:30 to 14:30 those with even numbers should be presented. The poster boards 119 cm high and 84 cm wide will be provided. Posters should be on the boards with designated poster numbers from 9:00 to 18:00 on the assigned day. Push-pins will be provided to mount posters.
